FIRST ROUND TEAM HISTORY:

DIVISION I

Waianae Seariders (9-3) vs. Kahuku Red Raiders (11-0)

Friday, Nov. 13, 4:30 p.m., at Aloha Stadium

OIA third place Waianae is coming off a 21-6 first-round win over MIL champion Baldwin, last week Friday at Aloha Stadium. This marks the Seariders sixth semifinal in seven tries at the state title. In its last appearance in 2010, Waianae finished runner-up, after falling to Saint Louis, 36-13, in the finale.

But this week, Waianae goes head-to-head with OIA champion and top seeded Kahuku, making its 13th state tournament appearance, and first under head coach Vae Tata.

The teams last met earlier this season on Oct. 3, with the Red Raiders victorious, 30-0, limiting the Seariders to just 48 yards of total offense. The points put up by the Red Raiders in the win was their third lowest scoring output of the season, as Kahuku outscored opponents 484-39 in 11 contests.

The Red Raiders are seasoned in state tournament play, boasting a 21-5 record (0.808 pct.), and capturing the state title seven times – more than any other team.

Mililani Trojans (10-2) vs. #2 Saint Louis (8-1)

Friday, Nov. 13, 7:30 p.m., at Aloha Stadium

Defending state champion Mililani has found new life with the return of quarterback McKenzie Milton in the lineup, but the Trojans face another test as they go head-to-head against ILH champion and second seeded Saint Louis this Friday in the semifinal round of the state championship.

FIRST ROUND TEAM HISTORY (continued):

Saint Louis is making its ninth state tournament appearance, and its fourth under head coach Cal Lee. During those three years Lee won the inaugural HHSAA state championship in 1999, and was runner up in 2000 and 2001.

DIVISION IILahainaluna Lunas (7-5) at #1 Kapaa

Saturday, Nov. 14, 3:00 p.m., at Vidinha Stadium, Kauai

MIL champion Lahainaluna is coming off a first-round win over the OIA's Kaimuki, 7-0, at the Lunas' home field. The Lunas next travel to the Garden Isle to face KIF champion and top seeded Kapaa at Vidinha Stadium, Saturday.

This trip will be a de ja vu for the Lunas, as both teams met earlier this season at Kapaa on Aug. 15, with Warriors victorious, 14-10. Kapaa netted 268 yards of offense to Lahainaluna's 115.

Lahainaluna is making its ninth straight state tournament appearance, more than any other team in the division. During that span, the Lunas reached the semifinal round eight times and was runner-up twice.

This marks Kapaa's third state tournament appearance.

Konawaena Wildcats (11-1) vs. #2 Radford (11-0)
Saturday, Nov. 14, 5:00 p.m., at Ticky Vasconcellos Stadium, Roosevelt High School, Honolulu

BIIF champion Konawaena is coming off a wild 42-33 win over ILH champion Damien, last week in Kealakekua. It was a tale of two halves as the Wildcats held a commanding 33-6 lead at halftime, to let the Monarch make a fourth quarter run, closing within six points toward the end of the game. Konawaena held Damien's late offensive charge, but next face another formidable opponent in OIA champion Radford.

Radford is making their fourth state tournament appearance under the helm of Fred Salanoa, who has guided the Rams to two runner-up finishes in 2005 and 2008. The Rams are undefeated this season and have outscored their opponents 432-52 in 11 games.

Konawaena is making its fifth D2 appearance, sixth overall, this time under first-year head coach and alum, Brad Uemoto. Uemoto served four seasons as OC under retired coach Cliff Walters, which the Wildcats appeared in states three of those years.

THIS WEEK'S TELEVISION COVERAGE:

OC16 will broadcast the Division I first-round doubleheader live from Aloha Stadium, Friday, Nov. 13. The early match-up kicks off at 4:30 p.m. featuring OIA third place Waianae (9-3) versus OIA champion and top seed Kahuku (11-0). The late game, slated for 7:30 p.m., features OIA runner-up Mililani (10-2) against ILH champion and #2 Saint Louis (8-1).

Calling the play-by-play for both games is Felipe Ojastro, with color commentary by John Veneri in the early game, and Darren Hernandez in the late game. Sideline reporting will be by Jenn Boneza.
