Kickoff for the Division II championship between #1 Iolani (11-2) and #2 Kauai (10-0) is set for 4:30 p.m. The Division I championship between #1 Kahuku (12-0) and #2 Kamehameha (11-1) will follow the DII championship at 7:30 p.m.

**THIS WEEK'S TELEVISION COVERAGE:**

The Division I and II football championships doubleheader, scheduled for Friday, Dec. 4, will be shown live by Pay-Per-View only on channels 260 &

1260. The game will not be shown live on OC16.

The DII championship game kicks off at 4:30 p.m. followed by the DI championship at 7:30 p.m. Oahu customers who order the game early will get the double header for \$29.95, while orders on the day of the games will be \$49.95. Neighbor island orders will be \$14.95 prior to game day, while game day orders will be \$24.95.

Customers who wish to watch the game live via the web will be charged \$10 to view both games on [www.oceanic.com](http://www.oceanic.com). Customers can only purchase the webcast from 3:30 p.m. on game day.

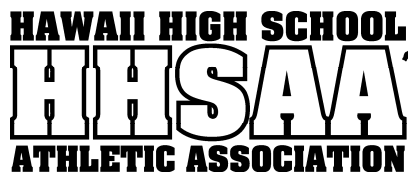
